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Home Discharge Instructions: Shoulder Replacement

Current medications:

New Medications:

1) Blood Thinner

Fragmin 5000 units subcutaneously every 24 hours

- Your last dose of Fragmin will be on

OR

Aspirin (Enteric-Coated) 325 mg daily x 4 weeks

2) Pain Medications

Percocet 5/325 mg tablet by mouth every 4-6 hours as needed for pain

Oxycodone 5 mg tablet by mouth every 4-6 hours as needed for pain

Vicodin 5/500 mg tablet by mouth every 4-6 hours as needed for pain

Tylenol 650 mg tablet by mouth every 4-6 hours as needed for pain

Dilaudid 2-4 mg tablet by mouth every 4-6 hours as needed for pain

3) Other

Phenergan 25 mg tablet by mouth every 6 hours as needed for nausea

Colace 100 mg tablet by mouth every 6 hours as needed for constipation

Ferrous Sulfate 324 mg tablet by mouth every 12 hours (may cause constipation / dark stools)

Vitamin C 500 mg tablet by mouth every 12 hours

OTHER INSTRUCTIONS:

- **Follow shoulder exercises as instructed by the Physical Therapist in the hospital.**

Avoid:

- Extension behind your body.
- Active internal rotation (to protect the subscapularis repair)
- External rotation beyond 30° (to protect the subscapularis repair)

Do:

- **Remember to move your elbow and hand through full range of motion daily, to prevent stiffness.**
 - Ice the shoulder using your cryocuff.
 - Keep your arm in the sling at all times except while showering or doing your exercises.
 - OK to do active assist forward flexion with pulley.
 - Keep dressings clean and dry. Dressings may be changed by your home health nurse. Take the dressing off 3 days after surgery. You can cover the suture area with a light dressing to protect it.
- **Report any problems immediately to your physician:**
 - **Fevers higher than 101.5°**
 - **Increasing pain**
 - **Chills**
 - **Wound drainage**
 - **Calf tenderness**
 - **Shortness of breath**
 - Home Health may see you in your home for wound care, blood draws, and physical therapy if needed.
